Who: Registered Girl Scouts age 8 (in second grade) or above, adult volunteers or Girl Scout alumnae willing to commit to at least one event per calendar quarter, be available for 1 to 2 training sessions per calendar year, is flexible and creative and committed to the Girl Scout Promise and Law.

What: Tulip Trace Ambassadors or members of the Tulip Trace Speakers Bureau share news about the council and the impact that the Girl Scout Program has on girls, women and the communities in which they live and work. These girls, women and men have an intimate knowledge of Girl Scouting and share their experiences with local civic groups, media representatives and through their interactions in their community.

When: Varies. Ambassadors are asked to commit to one event per calendar quarter. The length of time an event will take depends on the nature of the event. Quarterly training sessions will be scheduled as needed to update Ambassadors on new program activities, council news and upcoming events.

Where: Event locations vary. However, every effort will be made to keep Ambassadors or Speakers service within the service unit in which they live.
